ABOUT US:

Blasted out of solid rock cliff by three Creede miners, construction of the museum began in 1990. County-hired laborers and volunteers completed all other work, including rock removal, cribbing, rock battling, and cement work. The next summer, tours were given to show actual mining in operation. The miners created 200 feet of drift with 22 displays, a gift shop, and the Creede Community Center. In the spring of 2019, heavy snowmelt caused significant damage to the original cribbing. A local crew was brought in to construct a new awning and gift shop entranceway.
